Agenda Due | Status Item Notes Responsibility Name No. Date 22-MAY-19 (GV) Jetco has provided updated fan coil shop drawings showing the side filter access hatch. Fan Coil Drawings are currently in review with mechanical engineer. Cormode has requested a mock up unit be Filter 001 shipped for final review & confirmation of access hatch location. Once finalised it was suggested a New Access template be created that marks the outline of the unit & fan coil pipes on the floor of the mechanical Hatch rooms Corridor 22-MAY-19 (GV) Sample of corridor ceiling framing has been installed so corridor ceiling heights could be 002 Ceiling finalised. With this information it was determined that mechanical grilles would go in the face of bulkhead New Heights and not underneath. Bed Bug 003 22-MAY-19 (GV) Bed bug plugs have been identified on electrical Notice of Change E6. New Plugs 22-MAY-19 (GV) The mechanical drawings currently show the elevator exhaust moving air into the corridor of the fourth floor. Due to clearance issues, Jetco suggested utilising a roof mounted dome fan to the top of the shaft. Nowak Engineering to review and comment. Ventilation 004 New Garbage Room Exhaust Issues Actual exhaust fan for garbage room riser is in the fourth floor garbage room. Jetco expressed concern about the clearance under the duct work and fan in this room. Jetco suggested utilising a roof mounted dome fan for this system. Nowak Engineering to review and comment. 22-MAY-19 (GV) Emmanuel Home had some concerns about the traps drying out on the fan coil / Fan Coil 005 corridor pressurisation units condensate drain lines during the heating seasons. Jetco proposed a deep New Odor Issues trap to prolong protection which Emmanuel was in favour of. 22-MAY-19 (GV) Dryer vents will all be going vertical through the roof. Discussion around how to provide Dryer Vent 006 required rating to these ducts determined that the best solution would be to utilise a fire barrier duct wrap. New Stacks Jetco has provided product literature and a cost proposal for review and consideration. 22-MAY-19 (GV) Architectural drawings call for roof drains to the elevator roof and the roof above ST-03 however mechanical drawings don't show any drainage to these locations. Sloped insulation will be updated to slope and drain to lower roof via scupper & external down pipe. Roof 007 Drainage New Architectural drawings show emergency overflow roof drains about halfway between the roof drain and Plan the outside wall but mechanical calls for overflow drains set a coupe feet away from roof drain but set 150mm above roof surface. Architect and mechanical don't have a preference and will let Jetco decide on option. 22-MAY-19 (GV) Kamwin has confirmed electrical transformer will be positioned in the electrical room Transformer 800 New 22-MAY-19 (GV) Cormode has requested that roof drains be plumbed up to roof and connected in **Roof Drains** 009 New advance of starting the roof which is scheduled for mid-June. Ventilation 22-MAY-19 (GV) Ventilation unit #4 located in office 102 does not have plumbing available for the 010 New Unit #4 condensate drain. Jetco to provide RFI to Nowak for review. Office 114 -22-MAY-19 (GV) Jetco mentioned that a rough opening was missing for the ventilation unit positioned in **VU Supply** New the back of Office 114. Air
