PRIVATE LOAN PROGRAM Investment Opportunity!

Construction of the Lighthouse is proceeding very closely to the schedule set at the start of this project. While we are relying on bank financing to finish this new facility, we are hoping to reduce our need for this form of funding. This is where the Private Loan Program comes in.

Members of the Society can invest in the Society through an investment of \$25,000 or more, that pays interest at rates competitive with those being paid by most banks.

Terms are available from 1 year to 5 years. A T5 is issued each year for the interest earned on the investment, and the interest itself is paid out on December 31 each year, or (at the investor's option) added to the principal.

This is a great way to help us out! These investments help the Society by reducing bank debt, which reduces interest costs and eventual payment amounts. It also is a good sign to the banks that our Society is strong and supportive.

Current Rate Schedule:

1 – under 2 years: 4.5% 2 – under 3 years: 4.25% 3 – under 4 years: 4.0% 4 – 5 years: 4.0%

Accreditation Canada is a Canada-wide, industry-known set of standards that allows the public to see that we provide quality service.

This survey took place on March 6,7,8, 2023. This audit is done by two industry peers who review the policies and procedures of the organization to ensure that we provide quality care and a safe home for seniors. This is quite a rigorous survey and is only the beginning of the much larger one, called the Qmentum Survey, that Emmanuel Home plans to achieve in 2025.
