Reporting to the Director of Care, the Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) provides high-quality, personcentered care to Home Care and Supportive Living clients at Emmanuel Home. The LPN functions within the full scope of practice as outlined by the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Alberta (CLPNA) and is responsible for the day-to-day delivery of healthcare services in accordance with organizational policies and nursing care standards.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Deliver safe, competent, and evidence-based nursing care within scope of practice.
- Perform data entry for care plans and Home First documentation.
- Maintain and update accurate resident care records in accordance with Emmanuel Home's records management systems.
- Collaborate with the interdisciplinary healthcare team to support and enhance resident well-being.
- Assess, monitor, report, and document changes in residents' physical, mental, or emotional health.
- Assist residents with activities of daily living while promoting independence and dignity.
- Provide education and relevant health information to residents and their families.
- Demonstrate effective communication, interpersonal, and conflict resolution skills.
- Maintain a professional, respectful, and compassionate approach in all interactions with residents, families, and colleagues.
- Maintain accurate records and documentation in accordance with regulatory requirements.
- Participate in ongoing professional development and maintain competency as per CLPNA standards.
- Contribute to a safe, secure, and healthy work environment by adhering to safety protocols and infection prevention measures.

Qualifications:

Graduate of a recognized Licensed Practical Nurse program.

- Active registration and in good standing with the CLPNA.
- Current certification in CPR (Basic Life Support).
- Proficiency with computers and electronic documentation systems is an asset.
- Experience in geriatric or supportive living settings is preferred.
- High level of confidentiality and professional discretion.
- Strong written and verbal communication in English.
- Detail-oriented with a strong focus on accuracy and recordkeeping.
- Excellent interpersonal skills with a compassionate and courteous approach.
