1. Residents

a. 2 residents passed away this week

2. Staff

- a. Jane Beck, Kitchen & Housekeeping Manager, retired in July, after 27 years of employment at Emmanuel Home. A retirement party was held for her in early August.

3. 2020 Budget Planning

- a. Budget planning has been underway for a number of weeks now, to stay ahead of the North Wing planning. Laura & Donna, in their new roles, are getting up to speed on their departments and related budgets. The budget itself, in terms of operating the existing Emmanuel Home, isn't too complicated. The work we have to do is in forecasting the North Wing expenses, and then adding in potential Life Lease scenarios.

- c. Under the ministerial supervision of Classis Northern Alberta, but as an employee of our Society, we can demonstrate to our membership that we remain committed to our Christian foundation and principles while we pursue growth.
 - i. Of course, chaplaincy isn't the only way to demonstrate that commitment. But, I think there's a real opportunity here!
